

Two people aboard a small plane died after their aircraft crashed into a General Mills plant in Georgia Thursday evening, a report said.

The small Cessna 340 twin engine went down shortly after taking off from Covington Municipal Airport's runway, 30 miles east of Atlanta, at about 6:45 p.m., [WAGA-TV](#) reported, citing officials.

The two victims were the sole occupants of the plane, reports said.
